

RVA Street Eats COVID Policy

ACCA Shriners encourages practices by our staff and guests that will offer protection and safety to all. *If Federal and State COVID regulations permit us to hold RVA Street Eats on Sunday, September 27, 2020 we will do so in accordance with recommended procedures.* The food trucks and beverage stations will be spaced to offer opportunity for proper social distancing. Traffic flow will be directed to avoid cross-traffic. Admittance will be limited to whatever the legal number for group events are at the time.

We ask your cooperation in following the requested guidelines below:

- **Guests are encouraged to wear facemasks when not eating and maintain a minimum of 6 feet of personal space from others outside of your immediate family members.**
- **Please wear your facemask when ordering from a food truck and picking up a beverage from the beer/wine stations – this is to protect the personnel who come in contact with many people throughout the day.**
- **We will have sanitizing lotion available throughout the grounds – you are encouraged to use the lotion before and after eating.**
- **With the exception of inclement weather, seating inside the pavilion is discouraged. However, tables will be properly spaced and limited to only 4 persons per table.**
